Environmental Policy Statement

WW Martin Ltd is committed to both the protection of the environment and evaluating the impact that its construction activities can have.

Compliance with the UK's legislation is the minimum standard and the Company shall endeavour to follow best practice with due regard for business needs, in line with the requirements of ISO 14001:2015 and other requirements, such as those of the client. The objectives for the Company are to:

1. Reduce the consumption of fuel used by the fleet overall.
2. Reduce the energy consumed at Dane Park Road.
3. Increase the variety and quantity of materials segregated for recycling.

The Senior Managers will be responsible for communicating and implementing this Policy and will ensure that:

- a. Controls are implemented to prevent, avoid or minimize pollution in all forms wherever possible.
- b. The production of all types of waste is minimised. Maximise recycling, and dispose of other waste that cannot be avoided, in a responsible manner.
- c. Employees and sub-contractors are encouraged to avoid environmental damage and to report breaches of this policy to the Environmental Representative (see Employee Handbook).
- d. Resources and energy are used wisely.
- e. Training is provided as part of staff development taking into account responsibilities.

The Environmental Representative retains Pollution Prevention Guidelines which must be observed. Copies are available upon request.

The Board of Directors are committed to continually improving its performance by regularly reviewing its environmental impacts, and on an annual basis, update this policy in line with the review findings.
